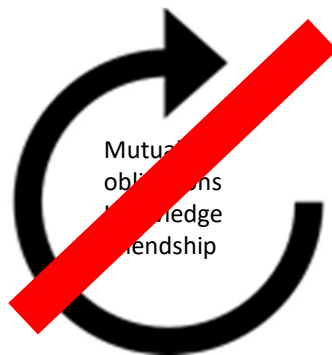
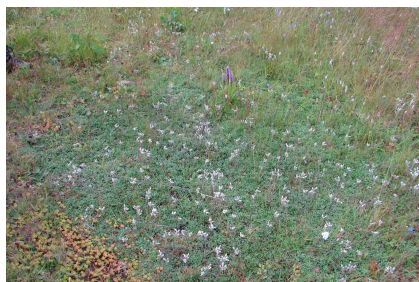


Capital development and exchange (ABS)

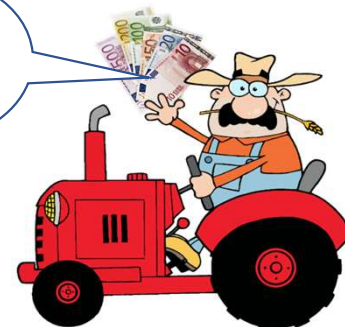

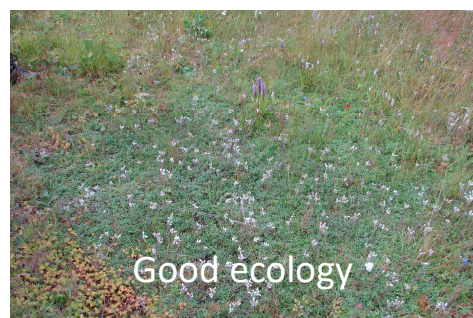

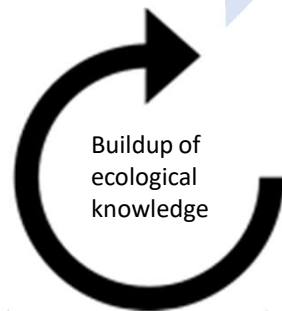
